

Belize to Guatemala – El Melechor

1. Documents
 - a. Passport
 - b. Driver's license – 1 copy
 - c. Vehicle title – 1 copy
 - d. Registration – 1 copy
2. Belize Exit
 - a. Park in front of large building ignoring tramitadores
 - b. Belize immigration - first desk
 - i. stamp out and pay exit fee of B37.50/each.
 - c. Belize customs – go through door to left of immigration to customs desk.
 - i. Cancel vehicle import fee – no inspection
3. Guatemala Entry
 - a. Drive through fumigation 'garage' we don't think we even got sprayed and parked to the right in front of building where we paid fumigation fee of Q18. Keep receipt!
 - b. Guatemala immigration - Across the street is a large open-air building. Immigration desk is to the far right. We were taken for the illegitimate 20Q/person fee. When I asked for a receipt, he stated the stamp in our passport was a receipt. I should have stuck to it seeing as not a single person after us paid the fee.
 - c. Guatemala Customs - desk immediately to the left of immigration
 - i. Official will go out and inspect VIN # of vehicle and fill out an enormous amount of paperwork.
 - ii. Pay vehicle import fee at banjercito, small window to the right of the immigration desk, \$20.44 and bring receipt back to customs official to receive permit.
 - d. Drive over bridge and pay municipal tax anywhere from 50-80Q, only for foreign plated vehicles.
4. Total Cost
 - a. Belize exit fee – B 37.50/person (\$18.75)
 - b. Fumigation 18Q (\$2.30)
 - c. Vehicle import fee – 160Q (\$20.44)
 - d. Municipal Tax – 50-80Q (\$6.39-9)
