

Guatemala to Honduras – El Florida

1. Documents
 - a. Passport
 - b. Driver's license – 2 copies
 - c. Vehicle title – 2 copies
 - d. Registration – 2 copies
 - e. Canceled Guatemala vehicle permit – 2 copies
2. Guatemala Exit
 - a. Parking is on the right, offices are in building to the left
 - b. Guatemala Immigration – window to the far right
 - i. Exit stamp in passport
 - ii. Exit fee 10Q/person (\$1.28) – may or may not have been legitimate
 - c. Guatemala Customs – window to the far left
 - i. Customs official did not inspect vehicle
 - ii. Ask for two copies of your canceled Guatemala vehicle permit
3. Honduras Entry
 - a. Drive across and park in front of large, new building on your right
 - b. Honduras Immigration – office is on the very left
 - i. Fill out immigration paperwork and pay \$3/person entry fee.
 - ii. Official staples paperwork and receipt in passport along with stamp.
 - c. Honduras Customs – office immediately to the right of immigration
 - i. Give official originals plus two copies of each driver's passport, license, title, registration, canceled Guatemala permit
 - ii. Exchange money while customs official is filling out miles of paperwork, the bank only accepts Honduran Lempiras.
 - iii. When paperwork is filled out, the official walked us to the bank where we paid the \$33.43 vehicle import permit fee.
 - iv. Walked back to customs office to stamp vehicle into Ken's passport.
 - d. Fumigation
 - i. Station is to the right just past immigration/customs building
 - ii. Pay fee across the street in blue and white building \$3.50.
4. Total Cost
 - a. Guatemala exit fee – 10Q/person (\$1.28)
 - b. Honduras entry – 60 L (\$3)
 - c. Honduras vehicle import – 666 L (\$33.43)
 - d. Fumigation 70 L (\$3.50)
