

Honduras to Nicaragua – Los Manos

1. Documents
 - a. Passport
 - b. Driver's license
 - c. Vehicle title – 1 copy
 - d. Registration
2. Honduras Exit – drive past huge long line of trucks outside of border
 - a. Park in front of dinghy building on the left
 - b. Honduras immigration – far right window
 - i. Exit stamp
 - ii. Exit fee of 140L/each (\$7)
 - c. Honduras customs – far left window
 - i. Official did not check vehicle, merely canceled permit
3. Nicaragua Entry
 - a. Fumigation
 - i. To the right after passing through gate
 - ii. Pay in office up the flight of stairs 91 C (\$3.73)
 - b. Park in front of buildings to the left
 - c. Nicaragua Immigration – window to the far right
 - i. Did not need to fill out any paperwork despite tramitadores shoving all sorts of forms in our faces.
 - ii. Receive tourist card and receipt for \$12/person entry fee.
 - d. Nicaragua Customs – window to far left
 - i. Wait in the slowest line yet for official to enter information onto import permit form.
 - ii. Once information is entered find customs inspection official (not in a uniform, just look for the guy inspecting vehicles)
 - iii. He gave our truck a cursory once over and signed the import permit
 - iv. Return to customs to receive import stamp
 - e. Nicaragua mandatory insurance – sketchy building on the left before chain across the road
 - i. \$12 USD for 1 month
 - f. Municipal Tax \$1/person
 - g. Before we were allowed to drive across the chain an official checked all our paperwork and passports.
4. Total Cost
 - a. Honduras exit fee – 140L each/\$7
 - b. Fumigation – 91C (\$3.73)
 - c. Nicaragua entry – 600 C (\$12/person)
 - d. Nicaragua vehicle import permit – free
 - e. Nicaragua insurance – 300C (\$12) for 1 month
 - f. Municipal Tax – 50C (\$1/person)
